


Condover Parish Neighbourhood Plan VISION MAP: 9th May 2017

- Small scale social housing development (max 10 houses) to meet local need (eg local connection / work etc)
- Retain countryside environment to maintain rural character
- Develop heritage trail, and nature reserve on extinct quarry sites with some public access
- Provide short lengths / areas on A49 where overtaking can place safely
- Development should take account of restricted lanes. Businesses and new developments should be conditional on provision of passing places
- Protection of hedgerows
- Support and improve leisure facilities
- Retain local facilities such as pubs and shops
- Maintain and improve schools
- Expand the facilities of the medical centre
- Rights of Way: mapping and improving and working with P3 Group
- Parking to be improved

ADDITIONAL VISION EMERGING FROM WHOLE GROUP DISCUSSION

- Retain the parish and village boundaries: to retain the sense of place and identity, and to manage development to ensure needs are met not just opportunities taken
- Support affordable rural exception sites
- Managed and manageable approach to traffic link safety of roads to sustainability of facilities
- Identify A49 through the Parish as an 'accident blackspot'
- Support rural enterprise eg. flexible work spaces; rural enterprise hubs; pop-up spaces; local
 provision of advice, mentoring and support for businesses / drop-in business clinics;
 encourage and improve business networking and skill-sharing
- Make full use of existing employment sites
- Engage people in activities locally: improve health and well-being, ensure people feel involved, build appreciation of the local community and natural environment

- Encourage sustainable tourism
- Build and support partnerships and networking
- Encourage and facilitate volunteering, in community activities, environment and heritage
- Encourage and make full use of Nextdoor
- Improve communication and co-operation between community-based organisations eg churches, village halls, community support groups
- Build an infrastructure for communication within the Parish and with neighbouring parishes
