


CONDOVER PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN CONSULTATION RESPONSES

In October 2018, the Parish Council asked residents to tell us their views on aspects of community life.



Location of respondents




We wanted to understand the things you like best about living in the Parish, the things we should include in the Neighbourhood Plan keep and support

Best things about living in Condover Parish




What needs improving in the Parish?


Use of parish amenities




Parish amenities will be an important part of the Neighbourhood Plan and we wanted to understand how much they are being used.

Traffic and transport issues




Leisure and Facilities


Heritage and Natural Environment
