1. **Introduction.** The previous meeting notes were reviewed.
2. **Action points**
 - a. The Local Plan target for Dorrington is 62 new homes. SG recommended that CPC seeks to deliver 55 houses in Dorrington as part of the Neighbourhood Plan. **CPC to confirm**
 - b. A windfall and Infill housing allowance of 7 houses was accepted as part of the Plan. **CPC to confirm**
 - c. Edward to contact SC (Eddie West) for the housing site picture – **Option 2 diagram still required**
 - d. Edward to Schools to obtain drawings and pictures identifying each village – **No response to request**
 - e. Gary has sourced the drone pics
 - f. Social media will be ready for 12 Feb depending on up to date information
 - g. Libby is dealing with CPC website matters
 - h. Display have been found and are stored at DVH
 - i. Brigid has identified a contractor to carry out the feedback analysis of approx 20 questions. There will be separate votes for the housing sites solutions
3. **Consultation**
 - a. **Principles**
 - i. Wishes of the majority
 - ii. Transparent approach
 - iii. Every resident has an opportunity to see all aspects of the Plan
 - iv. Residents will be asked to express their preference and view's once only
 - v. Only Parish residents may utilise the sticker process
 - b. **Guidance**
 - i. We seek residents' **preferred option**
 - ii. A sticker must be placed on the appropriate, preferred diagram

- iii. Include comments on housing and any other CPNP matters on the stickers or separate, available paperwork
- iv. CPC will determine the preferred option on the basis of the largest numbers of stickers per diagram
- v. In the event of a tied number of stickers then comments will be taken into consideration and will be reviewed by the SG

4. Resources

- a. Funding of £5,620 has been granted to CPNP by Locality
- b. Flyers, banners, A3 and A4 posters now need to be printed. Rachel will finalise wording with Brigid

5. CPC topics

- a. Rachel will list CPC topics
- b. Rachel will amend the flyer to include a reference to;
 - i. "Shropshire Council funds for local projects will increase from 15% to 25% as a direct result of achieving our Neighbourhood Plan"
